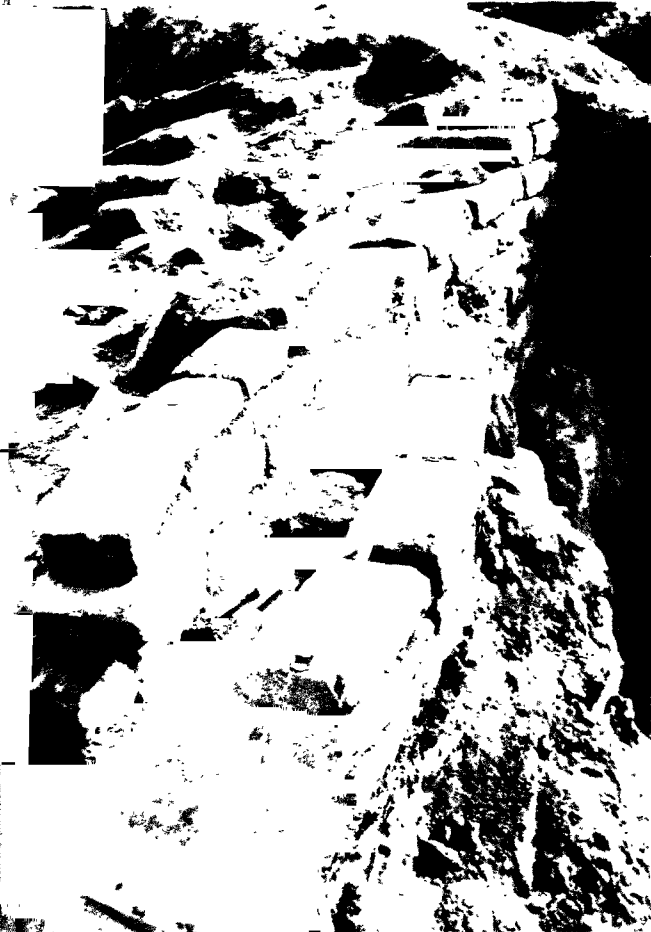

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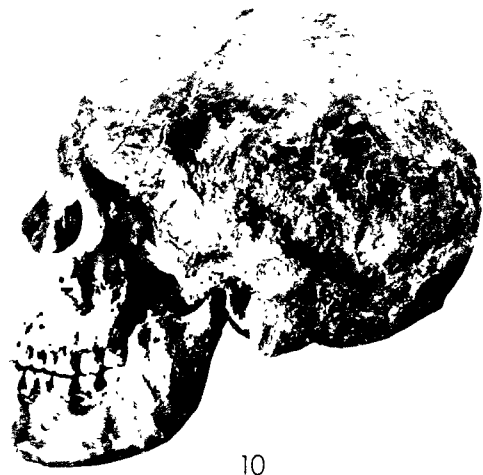
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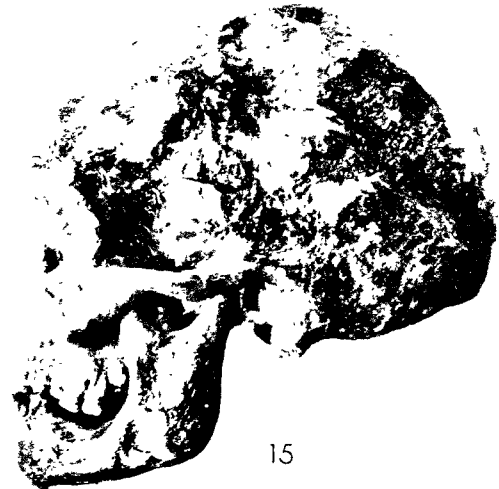
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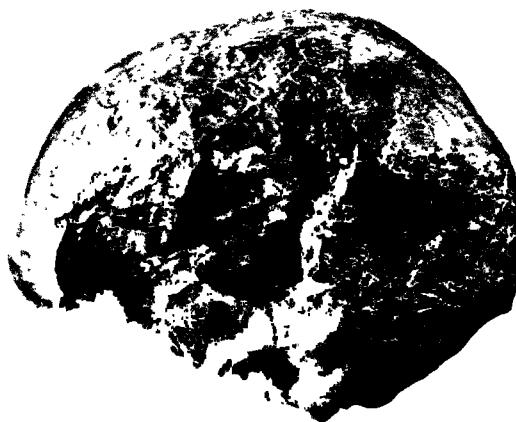
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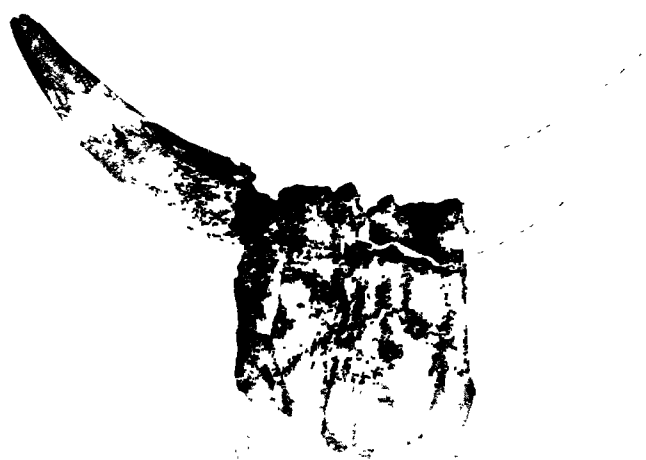
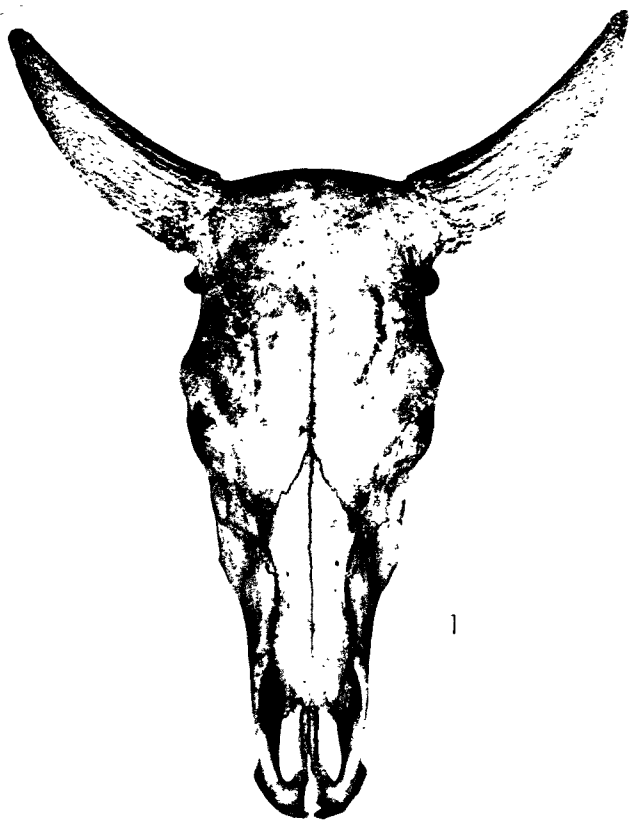

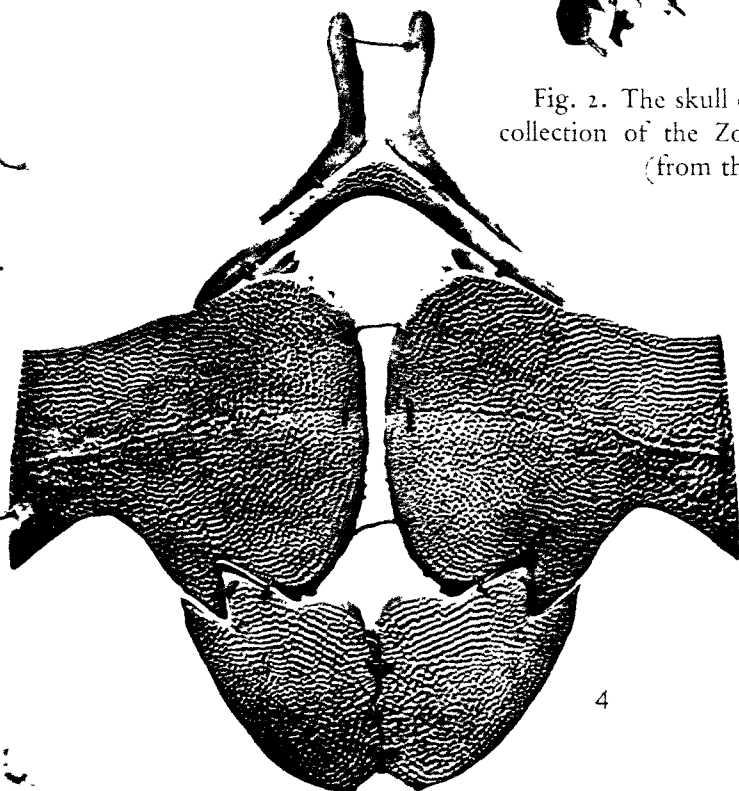
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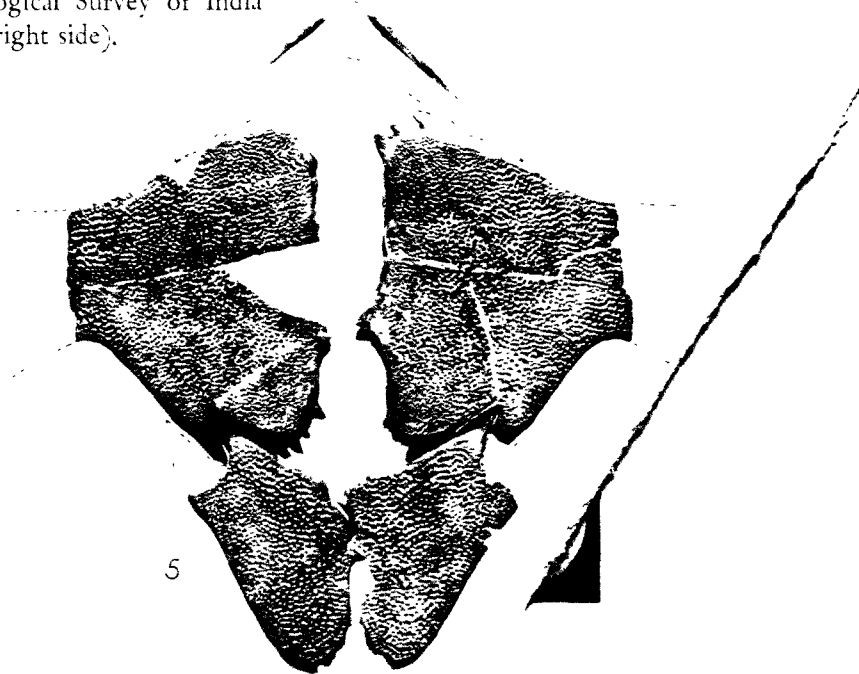


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Fig. 2. The skull of *Bos indicus* from the collection of the Zoological Survey of India (from the right side).

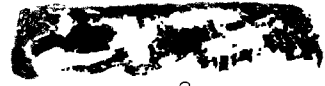




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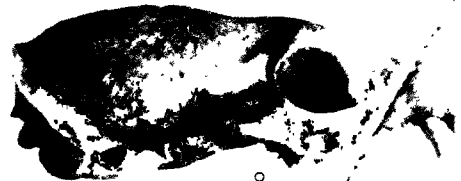
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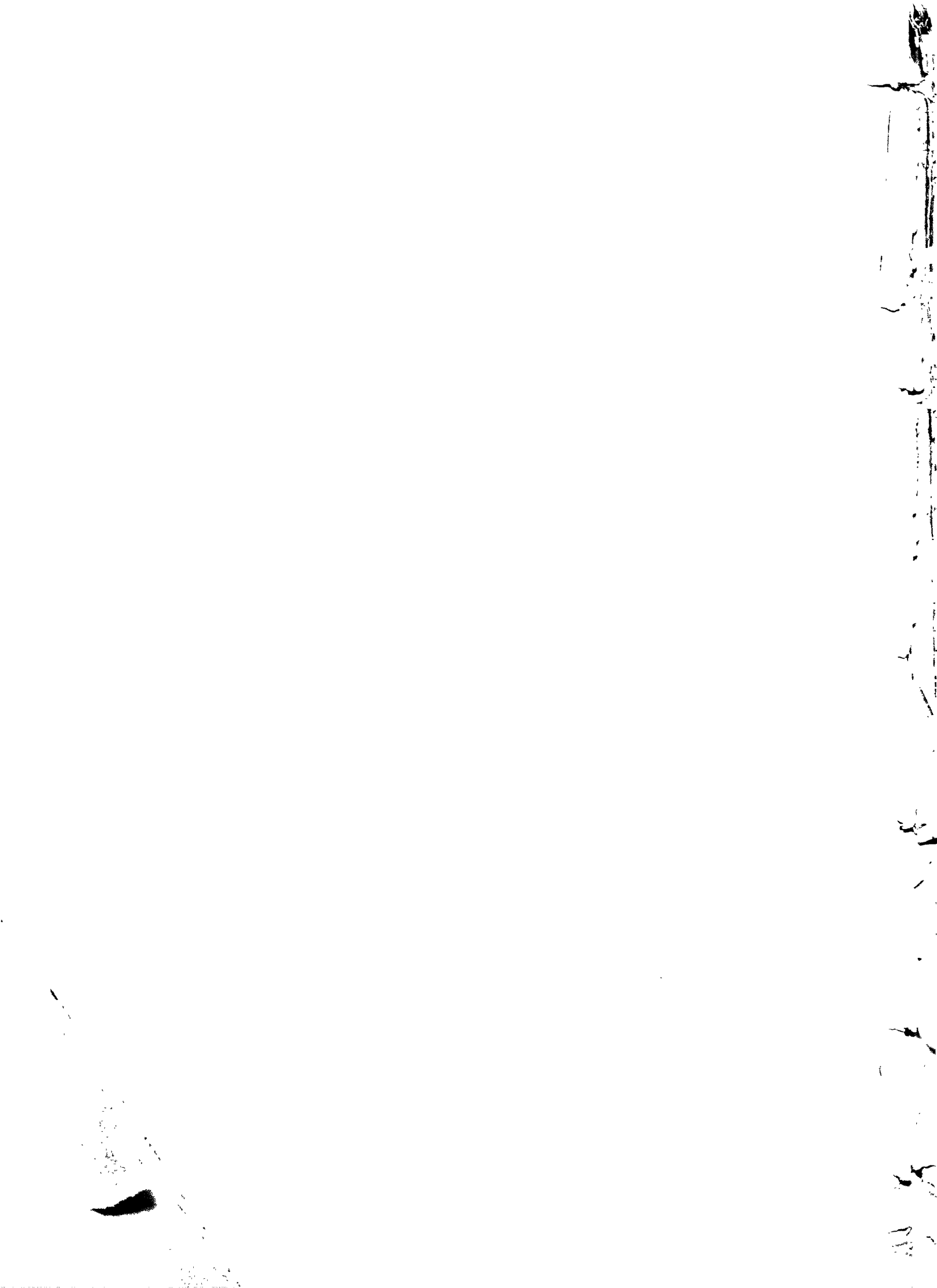
